

GERMANTOWN/GERMAN TWP

The Twin Valley was a "valley of peace" for the various Indian tribes hunting here. Germantown was settled in August, 1804, by German-speaking families from Pennsylvania. (The German language was spoken in Germantown until the early 1900s.) The Village incorporated in 1833.

In May 1976, the downtown core was recognized by the National Historical Park Service of the U.S. Department of the Interior as a National Historic Site and Historical Preservation District. Today, Germantown thrives as a quaint, quiet and pleasant Ohio village surrounded by rural German Township.

To enter Kindergarten, a child must be 5 years old on or before September 30 of the enrollment year and their parents or legal guardian must live within the Valley View Schools District. To enter first grade, a child must be 6 years old on or before September 30 of the enrollment year or have successfully completed one full year of public school Kindergarten.
