In honor of William Henry Harrison's presidential campaign slogan, Tippecanoe and Tyler, too! John Clark called his city to be Tippecanoe. A few years later, the citizens unofficially added City, and it was called this until 1938, when the legal name was shortened to Tipp City. Tipp City's small-town charm combined with easy accessibility to metropolitan attractions make it an ideal place to visit – or to put down roots.
